Summit Students Deliver “Foster Love” Care Packages

Many young children who find themselves in the foster care system arrive in placement under difficult circumstances and many of them without most of their personal belongings. One non-profit group in our area is working to help these children by providing care bags intended to make foster placement a more loving experience. The “Foster Love Project” collects donations of placement bags and comfort items to provide to children when they arrive in foster care. Each duffle bag or backpack includes new pajamas, a blanket, stuffed animal, book, toothbrush, toothpaste, bath soap and wash puff. On Wednesday, January 7, 2015, Summit Academy students participated in the placement bag distribution process for the Foster Love Project. Six young men loaded 1,345 placement bags into a truck and delivered them to eight foster agencies in Allegheny and Beaver Counties, making foster placement just a little more comfortable for kids across our region.
